Arriving:

When you drive into the grounds, members of the Front of House team will be at every junction to meet you and direct you to the car parks. They will be wearing yellow hi-viz jackets.





Parking:

If you have pre-booked Accessible Parking you will be directed to continue straight ahead when you arrive and the car park will be on the right, close to the auditorium. There will be a member of the Front of House team there also to direct you.





If you are parking in the main car park you will be directed to turn right when you arrive and to follow the lane down to the far end of the playing field.





As you approach the gates you will be directed to turn left, over the bridge and into the car park.





Walking to the auditorium:

Once you have parked your car, you will begin walking across the field. There will be members of the Front of House team stationed across the field who will help you if you need it. They will also have programmes and Tote Bags to sell if you would like one, and can answer any of your questions.





Food and Drink:

Before the performance the Snack Van will be open and you can buy crisps, chocolate, hot and cold drinks and ice creams. This will also be open during the interval. You are very welcome to bring your own food and drink and can picnic on the field before the performance and during the interval.



Information Tent:

Next to the Snack Van is the Information Tent. The Box Office team is stationed here if you have any queries about your tickets.



Toilets:

Toilets can be found just beyond the auditorium. There can sometimes be queues for the toilets.



Entering the auditorium:

There are two entrances to the auditorium. The pictures below show them before the gates are opened. There will be a member of the Backstage crew stationed at each entrance throughout the performance should you need anything. They will be wearing black and will have a headset on.





Quiet Tent:

There will be a Quiet Tent set up near the Information Tent should you need to take a break at any time and if you need to get up and move around during the performance, please feel free to do so.

Please note, there are very few shaded areas around the auditorium, and the auditorium itself will be in full sunlight during the performance, so please make sure to bring a hat, suncream and water.

Maureen and Darren are the Front of House Manager and Deputy and will be on hand at all times to help you with whatever you need.
